Session/Teams Snippets: Kirk Session always starts with an act of worship and discussion of an article. Next week, we will discuss The Bible Society's "The Quiet Revival One Year On", an investigation into contemporary faith which follows on from an earlier, somewhat flawed survey. This new study defends many of the original findings, reinforced with evidence from multiple sources. It presents a thought-provoking picture of growth in "active" Christianity and decline in "nominal" religion, as well as a greater propensity of prominent people to talk openly about their faith. It assembles evidence showing that "Generation Z" are more spiritual than their predecessors, often seeking spiritual and religious foundations for questions of identity, meaning and purpose.
